The Resource Room program is designed to develop, strengthen, and improve skills for positive academic performance and achievement.

The focus in Resource Room will be on explicit skill based instruction, learning strategies which focus on comprehension and memory skills, reading fluency, math skills, written expression, and organizational, study, and test taking skills.

There will also be a focus placed on self-advocacy skills as these are critical for future success. Students' progress will be monitored and reviewed throughout the year according to their IEP (Individualized Educational Plan).
